## 8. Phase 2 Status Report – Confirm/Refine the Phase 2 Projects for Feasibility Study Evaluation

Mike Savage and Jenny Gain provided an update on the current list of projects. They noted that there had been lots of input from the Member Agencies. They discussed the projects by agency and provided descriptive tables and maps for the projects. The list will need to be finalized at the January 26, 2015 Board and TAC meetings. Phil Miller requested a preliminary reallocation of Phase 1 costs for budget purposes. He indicated that he would like that by the end of January 2015.

### 9. Request from City of American Canyon to join NBWRA to Participate in Phase 2

Jason Holley provided a brief description of their future water recycling projects. The TAC discussed the possibility of the City becoming a member. Since their projects do not fit easily into the current project scope and time frame, no action was taken by the TAC. Tim Healy and Jason Holley will discuss ways to incorporate a City project into the current NBWRA process and report back at the January 26, 2015 TAC meeting.

### 10. Program Development / Federal Advocacy Update / State Advocacy Update

Ginger Bryant and Pilar Oñate-Quintana provided on update on various state and federal issues for the TAC. Bryant discussed efforts to fix an error in federal language to allow funding for Phase 2 projects. She noted elected officials support for the language change. She also discussed 2015 planning activities including Washington D.C. strategies and a planned trip to D.C. in early February 2015. Oñate-Quintana discussed implementation of the Water Bond that passed in November 2014, potential NBWRA involvement in proposed language developed by Irvine Ranch Water District related to recycled water use during draught curtailments, and that NBWRA Day in Sacrament is tentatively planned for March 4, 2015.

### 11. Outreach Program Report

Mark Millan discussed the videos and an article in the North Bay Business Magazine. He will send a link for the article to the Program Manager for distribution.

## 12. Status of WaterSMART Grants and Applications

The latest grant application is due December 15, 2015.
