The Agenda was unanimously approved.

3. Public Comments

There were no public comments.

The January 25, 2016 Meeting Minutes were unanimously approved.

5. Report from the Program Manager

The Report from the Program Manager included the following items:

5.a Action Items from the January 25, 2016 Meeting

The TAC reviewed the Action Item List and noted that all items were current.

6. Budget Impacts for FY2016/17 and FY2017/18 and Draft 2-Year Budget

The consultant team provided a PowerPoint presentation detaining budget issues. Mike Savage and Jim O'Toole described impacts on engineering, environmental, and public involvement. Ginger Bryant described impacts on program development and state and federal advocacy. Chuck Weir described impacts on program management. Kevin Booker and Jake Spaulding described impacts on SCWA administration, grant management, and EIR/EIS management.

The TAC discussed the issues and had questions regarding the level of effort for federal advocacy, particularly with respect to the RE-Act legislation. As an <u>action</u> item the TAC requested a list of participating organizations in sponsoring RE-Act and cost sharing, if available.

The TAC also discussed the increased costs for environmental analysis and requested additional detail on the costs. The TAC also inquired as to possible cost reductions if programmatic-only analysis was omitted. As an <u>action</u> item, the environmental costs will be revisited and estimate the cost savings for not conducting the programmatic-only analysis.

The Program Manager discussed the current draft 2-year budget and cost sharing possibilities. The TAC discussed cost sharing, truing up of Phase 2 costs, and applicable percentages. Following discussion additional <u>action</u> items included: 1) SCWA will review its costs and determine if the split between the two years should be modified; 2) cost sharing will be shown using both the current percentages and revised percentages based on the average of the project costs from May 2014 and January 2016.

Lastly, and as an <u>action</u> item a revised two-year budget with both cost sharing options will be distributed to the TAC as soon as revised costs are available from the consultants and SCWA. The intent is that a revised budget can be discussed by the TAC at the March 28, 2016 meeting, which will provide adequate time for agencies to discuss with their Boards/Councils such that the NBWRA Board can consider the two-year budget at its April 25, 2016 meeting.

7. MOU Issues – Purpose and Objectives

The TAC discussed the history of the proposed modifications to the purpose and objectives and how the modifications are helpful in obtaining future funding. The issue of reducing discharges to receiving waters was also discussed. Following discussion and as an <u>action</u> item, the TAC agreed with the current changes with the addition of a new objective: "*Maximize the development of recycled water projects to the extent practicable.*" The revised purpose and objectives will be presented to the Board for consideration at the March 28, 2016 work session.

8. Items from Committee, Agency, Staff, or Consultants

Mike Savage informed the TAC that the consultant team would be contacting the agencies to develop ongoing operation and maintenance costs for the Phase 2 projects in order to do proper life cycle analysis.

9. Items for Next Agenda, March 28, 2016 Web Meeting

Action items included the following:

1. Prepare a list of organizations and agencies sponsoring the RE-Act legislation and cost sharing, if possible.

- 2. Review the costs for environmental analysis, provide additional detail on the costs, and estimate the cost savings for not conducting the programmatic-only analysis.
- 3. Review the costs and split between years for SCWA administration, grant management, and EIR/EIS management.
- 4. Prepare a revised two-year budget using the revised costs and present member agency cost sharing using both the current percentages and revised percentages that are based on an average of the May 2014 and January 2016 project costs.
- 5. Add a new objective to the revised purpose and objectives from the MOU and present to the Board for consideration at the March 28, 2016 work session.

There being no further business, Chair Healy adjourned the meeting at 11:15 a.m.

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ITEM NO. <u>6</u> BUDGET IMPACTS FOR FY2016/17 AND FY2017/18 AND DRAFT 2-YEAR BUDGET

Recommendation

It is recommended that the TAC review the revised budget impacts and draft 2-Year Budget for FY2016/17 and FY2017/18 and reach consensus on Scenario 1, 2, or 3, as well as a cost sharing method for the next two years. Approval by the TAC will provide adequate time to discuss with their Boards and Councils and be prepared to discuss further at the March 28, 2016 TAC meeting. A final version is planned to be presented to the Board for approval at the April 25, 2016 meeting. Scenario 1 and cost sharing percent based on the average of the original project costs and the January 2016 project costs are recommended.

Please refer to the PowerPoint and budget spreadsheets for this item. Each of the consultants and SCWA will discuss cost impacts for FY2016/17 and FY2017/18.

Proposed Changes to Costs for FY2016/17

As described by the consultants there are the following possible changes to the FY2016/17 Budget due to the changes in the program that have occurred over the last two years:

- Increase from \$1,786,440 to:
 - o Scenario 1 \$2,429,584 (\$643,144 or 36.0%)
 - o Scenario 2 \$2,327,304 (\$540,864 or 30.3%)
 - o Scenario 3 \$2,365,881 (\$579,441 or 32.4%)
- \$51,872 for Workshops, Public Outreach, Management
- S1 = \$301,299; S2 = \$199,019; S3 = \$237,596; down from \$404,921 for Environmental Evaluation
- \$14,723 for Phase 2 Grant Applications
- \$42,000 for Federal Advocacy
- \$9,000 for State Advocacy
- (37,250) for Program Management
- \$260,000 for SCWA Administration, Grants, EIR/EIS

Proposed Budget for FY2017/18

Although there may be some work included in the FY2016/17 Budget that will carry over to FY2017/18, the Budget for FY2017/18 is significantly lower than FY2016/17. Activities are largely maintenance level for Program Development and Advocacy, Outreach, Program Management and SCWA Administration. The proposed FY2017/18 Budget includes the following:

- FY17/18 Total Budget of \$737,620
- Program Development/State and Federal Advocacy = \$347,200

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- Engineering/Environmental/Outreach = \$217,670
- Program Management = \$37,750
- SWCA Administration = \$135,000

4-Year Budget Versus 3-Year Budget (Revisions from February 18, 2016)

A summary of the changes in the previous 2-year Budget, which was presented to the TAC on February 18, 2016 versus the proposed 4-year Budget includes the following:

- 4-Year Budget versus 3-Year Budget (Revisions from 2/18/16)
- February 18 Version: \$6,420,823 versus \$4,985,479 (increase of 28.8%)
- Scenario 1: \$6,323,285 (reduction of \$97,538)
- Scenario 2: \$6,227,384 (reduction of \$193,439)
- Scenario 3: \$6,263,509 (reduction of \$157,314)
- Increase ranges from \$1,241,905 to \$1,337,806 (24.9% 26.8% for the additional year

Member Agency Cost Sharing


The proposed cost sharing for FY2016/17 and FY2017/18 is shown with both the original percentages, as well as the average percentages for all three scenarios. There have been changes in the number and cost of the projects and as a result, the current percentages may not be applicable. The following table summarizes the changes in percentages and the proposed percentage that is an average of the two.

It should be noted that the above costs as of January 2016 include both Title XVI and non-Title XVI Project Level EIR/EIS projects. The total for Napa San also includes the two MST projects that were discussed at the January meeting. The project costs for programmatic level projects have not been factored into this summary. The most significant change is the percentage for Novato SD. It is understood that there will be a "truing up" of Phase 2 costs once the EIR/EIS is certified and final project costs are fully defined. Graphically, the percentages look like this:

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In terms of cost impact, the following table summarizes the impacts for the 4-year Budget for all three scenarios. In terms of the total costs, the impacts are not very significant and will likely make the final truing up costs less significant.

Scenarios Addressed

- Cost Developed for 3 Scenarios:
- Project-Level and Program Level: Includes all projects identified
- Project-Level Projects Only: Drop the programmatic-level elements, which are primarily storage
- Project-Level Projects plus Lower Novato Creek at programmatic level

Why Include Lower Novato Creek in the Program?

An environmental project provides critical scoring when seeking construction funding

- The Salt Ponds served that role in Phase 1
- Lower Novato Creek Project serves that role in Phase 2

WaterSMART Funding is a Competition!

- 7 Evaluation Criteria worth 200 points must be addressed in a WaterSMART grant application
 - Criteria 1, 3 and 7 worth 80 points (40%) are about watershed based, environmental and water quality benefits
 - o High scores can only be attained with a regional-scale approach that includes environmental restoration and habitat benefits

 In Phase 1 Member Agencies that did not have a direct environmental project component received funding because of the Salt Ponds project by SVCSD

Why We Need Lower Novato Creek

- Phase 2 must have watershed based, environmental and water quality benefits to be successful in grant competition
- The Lower Novato Creek Project is the "right" type of project for scoring well in WaterSMART funding competition
- Programmatic analysis strategically benefits the Phase 2 Program
 - o Captures funding benefit
 - o Minimizes schedule risk
